

50 MANUEL DE FALLA COURSES
International Festival of Music and Dance of Granada

An application to participate in any of the activities (masterclasses, courses or workshops) included in the current edition of the Manuel de Falla Courses, involves acceptance of the following General Conditions of participation.

The organization of the Courses reserves the right to alter any of the contents of the masterclasses, courses or workshops scheduled. If any change is made, it will be announced on this website for general knowledge as soon as it is produced. Activities can also be **canceled** may them not attract a minimum number of applications.

1- Applications:

They will be submitted exclusively online, by filling in the registration form and attaching the relevant documentation. Applications must include a summarized CV and a **bank receipt** in confirmation of **payment of registration fees (except for applications to the Workshop on Inclusive Scene)**. The receipt must indicate **the name of the person** applying for the activity.

Incomplete applications or those submitted after the deadline will not be given consideration, even if the payment has been made within the deadline.

2-Fees

Registration fees of 30€ (**after bank commissions**) shall be paid within the deadline for registration by bank transfer to the following account:

Deadline for the payment of the rest of the fees will be 48 hours after notification of acceptance to the applicant. After this deadline, any participant who has not paid the appropriate course fee **will automatically be considered as not attending** the relevant activity.

Those students from any Spanish public conservatoire or university will have to prove their condition of student by sending the receipt of the payment of the corresponding fees.

For those applicants who wish to take part in more than one of the 50 Manuel de Falla Courses, only one registration fees of 30€ shall be paid.

Registration refunds:

Registration fees will only be refunded for academic or organizational reasons which are the responsibility of the organizers of the Courses, such as change of dates, cancellation of programmed masterclasses, courses or workshops, or total changes to programs or to their contents. Refunds will also be made to applicants not admitted to the activity, if they do not wish to attend as an observer (when possible).

Refund of the course fee due to renouncement of the applicant: they will be attended within the **10 days before** the beginning of the course. In this case, 80% of the fees will be refunded. After this deadline, no application will be attended.

In order to process a refund, the claim must be made in writing and must include full details of the bank account into which the refund is to be paid.

3- Selection process:

Photography workshop: those interested in taking part in this workshop must submit together with their application, a link to a photography dossier (Facebook blog, Flickr, etcetera), preferably including pictures of music or dance performances.

Masterclasses on choral conducting, piano and singing masterclasses: applicants must send a link to a video (YouTube, Vimeo...) with good quality of image and sound, with a duration of 5-10 minutes including a recent performance. They must also attach a short CV outlining studies and courses they have undertaken, concerts they have performed at, etcetera. Selection will be made by the teachers and acceptance will be notified to successful applicants by email.

Classical dance masterclasses: students who apply for these master classes are kindly requested to submit, together with their application, a CV and a link (Facebook, YouTube, Vimeo...) of a solo performance of an adagio and a waltz of no more than 3 minutes' duration. Selection will be made by the teacher and acceptance will be notified to successful applicants by e-mail.

Composition masterclasses: those interested in taking part in the composition masterclasses must send together with their application, a résumé as well as a copy of a composition of their own, for any kind of musical formation. Acceptance will be notified to successful applicants by e-mail.

4- Recording and public communication: students authorize the Organization of the Manuel de Falla courses to take images or to record classes and/or concerts where they take part, for archives and promotional (non- commercial) purposes

5-Scholarships

Scholarships (fees or accommodation) are available and can be applied for all the activities included in the 50 Manuel de Falla courses **except** for the **Workshop on inclusive scene, X ROCE meeting and the Course on music and visual arts: the painted stave.**

1- Fees: this scholarship covers only the course fee (registration fees not included).

2- Accommodation: this scholarship covers the costs of the accommodation (bed and breakfast) in a hotel appointed by the organizers, for the duration of the chosen activity.

In order to be eligible for **one** of the scholarships, it must be requested when completing the application form and, apart from the documentation required for each activity, the following documentation must also be provided:

- A photocopy of the Tax Return form of the applicant and the members of his/her family unit (even though the applicant may no longer be under their responsibility) applied to the last tax year.

- A photocopy of the applicant's academic certification together with the grades obtained and, if relevant, any other artistic or professional certificates.

The award of scholarships will be the responsibility of the Evaluating Committee of the Festival Internacional de Música y Danza de Granada. The Committee's resolution will be final.

Those applications that do not include the documentation required above will not be given consideration.

The award of scholarships involves the obligation to attend the whole activity. No absences will be admitted, except those properly justified. Non-fulfillment of this obligation may be cause of revocation of the grant.

6-Diploma

A diploma will be issued to those students who attend a minimum of 80% of the hours of each activity.

7- Accommodation:

Information about accommodation in Granada (descriptions and prices) will be made available to applicants who request it. Attendees are responsible for making their own reservation at the chosen establishment.
