Classical dance course

An application to participate in the **Course on classical dance** involves acceptance of the following Conditions of participation.

The organization of the Courses reserves the right to alter any of the contents of the course. If any change is made, it will be announced on this website for general knowledge as soon as it is produced.

The **Course on classical dance** could be canceled in the event of an insufficient number of participants or due to causes beyond the organization's control. It could also be cancelled due to the health measures that Spanish health authorities could take as a consequence of the pandemic caused by Covid-19. All fees will be fully refunded in the event of cancellation.

1. Applications:

They will be submitted exclusively online in this website, by filling in the registration form and attaching the relevant documentation. Please make sure to fill in all the relevant fields.

Incomplete applications or those submitted after the deadline will not be given consideration.

2. Fees

Registration fees shall be paid by bank transfer to the account below. Deadline for the payment will be **48 hours** after notification of acceptance to the applicant. After this deadline, any participant who has not paid the appropriate course fee **will automatically be considered as not attending** the course.

Students who apply for a grant will have to pay the fees within **48 hours** from the notification of the committee's resolution.

Any bank expense will be on account of the students.

Those students from any Spanish public dance conservatoire or university who would like to invoke special fees will have to prove their condition of student by sending the registration certificate corresponding to the course 2021-2022.

Registration refunds:

Registration fees will only be fully refunded for academic or organizational reasons which are the responsibility of the organizers of the Courses, such as change of dates, cancellation of the course or total changes to program or to its contents.

Refund of the course fee due to renouncement of the applicant: it can be attended if the refund is claimed no later than **10 days before** the beginning of the course. In this case, 80% of the fees will be refunded. After this deadline, no application will be attended.

In order to process a refund, the claim must be made in writing, and must include an explanation of the renouncement reasons, as well as full details of the bank account into which the refund is to be paid.

3. Places and selection process:

This course has a capacity of 20 seats. This number could be reduced due to health measurements as a consequence of the pandemic Covid-19.

Students who apply for this course are kindly requested to submit, together with their application, a CV and a link (Facebook, YouTube, Vimeo...) of a solo performance of an adagio and a waltz of no more than 3 minutes' duration. Selection will be made by the teacher and acceptance will be notified to successful applicants by e-mail.

4. Recording and public communication: students authorize the organization of the Manuel de Falla courses to take images or to record classes where they take part, for archives and promotional (non- commercial) purposes

5. Scholarships

Scholarships (fees) are available for active students. In order to be eligible for a scholarship, it must be requested when completing the application form and, apart from the documentation required for each activity, the following documentation must also be provided:

- A photocopy of the Tax Return form of the applicant and the members of his/her family unit (even though the applicant may no longer be under their responsibility) applied to the last tax year.

- A photocopy of the applicant's academic certification together with the grades obtained and, if relevant, any other artistic or professional certificates.

The award of scholarships will be the responsibility of the Evaluating Committee of the Festival Internacional de Música y Danza de Granada. The Committee's resolution will be final.

Those applications that do not include the documentation required above will not be given consideration.

The award of scholarships involves the obligation to attend the whole activity. No absences will be admitted, except those properly justified. Non-fulfillment of this obligation may be cause of revocation of the grant.

6. Responsibility, security and health measures

The organization of the Courses is not responsible for any accident it may occur as consequence of the student's participation in this activity. The International Festival of Music and Dance has contracted the insurances to cover civil responsibility of the activities scheduled.

The Courses will proceed with absolute respect to the sanitary rules and Spanish authorities' guidelines, by taking any health and security measure, in order to fight the spread of the Coronavirus, including the use of face masks and social distancing in all the activities and venues. All participants are kindly requested to follow the instructions from the Festival's staff.

7. Diploma and certificate

A diploma and a certificate will be issued to those students who attend a minimum of 80% of the hours of the activity. Certificates will be sent to the participants by email, electronically signed by the Festival's manager

8. Accommodation:

Information about accommodation in Granada will be made available to applicants who request it. Attendees are responsible for making their own reservation at the chosen establishment.
