### **Granada Festival Baroque Academy**

An application to take part in this activity involves acceptance of the following conditions of participation.

The organization of the Courses reserves the right to alter any of the contents of the Academy. If any change is made, it will be announced on this website for general knowledge as soon as it is produced. The Academy can also be **canceled** may it is not covered at least half the number of places offered. Additionally, it can be canceled due to the restrictions the authorities can ordered as consequence of the pandemic caused by Covid-19.

#### **1. Applications**

They will be submitted exclusively online, by filling in the registration form available on the Festival's website, including the relevant documentation.

**Incomplete applications or those submitted after the deadline will not be given consideration.**

#### **2. Places**

2 oboes, 1 bassoon, 5 first violins, 5 second violins, 4 violas, 2 cellos, 1 double bass, 1 harpsichord, 2 plucked strings

#### Selection process:

Those interested in taking part in the Academy are kindly requested to indicate in their application form, a link (YouTube or similar) to a video with good sound and image quality, including the performance of 2 or 3 works from the European Baroque, with or without accompaniment, and a duration of at least 5 minutes.

Deadline for applications: **April 18<sup>th</sup>** at 14pm. Successful applicants will be notified by e-mail

Selected participants will take place in the course, rehearsals and performances in the framework of the International Festival of Music and Dance of Granada.

#### **3. Recording and communication**

Participants authorize the organization of the Manuel de Falla courses to take images or to record classes, rehearsals and concerts where they take part, for archives and promotional (non- commercial) purposes.

#### **4.- Fees**

Activity free of fees for the active participants in the Academy. They will also receive a grant of a maximum amount of 250 € for their accommodation, per diems and/or travel expenses.

The payment will be made to a bank account indicated by the participants, once they are taking part in the course.

### **5. Responsibility, security and health measures**

The Courses are not responsible for any accident it may occur as consequence of the student's participation in the Granada Festival Baroque Academy. The International Festival of Music and Dance has contracted the insurances to cover civil responsibility of the activities scheduled.

The courses will proceed with absolute respect to the sanitary rules and Spanish authorities' guidelines, by taking any health and security measure, in order to fight the spread of the Coronavirus, including the use of face masks and social distancing in all the activities and venues. All participants are kindly requested to follow the instructions from the Festival's staff.

### **6. Diploma and certificates**

Participants can apply for a diploma and a certificate in case they attend at least 80% of the hours of the course. The certificate be sent by e-mail to the participants.

### **7. Accommodation**
