Singing Course

The application for registration in the **Singing Course** of the 54 Manuel de Falla Courses implies the acceptance of these conditions of participation.

The organization of the Manuel de Falla Courses reserves the right to modify any of the contents of this activity. Any changes will be announced at the time of their occurrence on this website.

The Singing course may be cancelled in case a minimum number of students do not register in the course. This number will be determined by the organization of the Courses at the end of the deadline for registrations.

1. Applications

They can be submitted exclusively online on this website, by completing the registration form and attaching the required documentation. Applications not accompanied by all the required documentation or those that are received outside the established registration period will not be met.

2. Fees

Fees must be paid by transfer to the following bank account (in the concept of the deposit, name of the student and the activity requested must be clearly specified):

Any expense generated by the banking operations will be borne by the applicants.

Once the applicant has been informed of his/her admission to the course, the payment of the tuition fee will be made within **48 hours** of the communication. If after this period the applicant has not proceeded to the formalization of said income, he/she will be automatically considered as not attending the course.

Deadline for students who apply for a grant is 48 hours from the notification of the committee's resolution.

Refund of fees

In the case of justified resignation of the selected student, 80% of the tuition fee can be refunded, provided that such refund is requested by e-mail and at least **10 days** before the start of the course. **Outside this period, no refund request will be met.**

The organization will only refund the full amount paid in case of cancellation, change of dates or total modification of the program or contents of the activity.

3. Scholarships

Scholarships covering tuition fees may be granted. Applicants must request it when completing the application form and the following documentation must also be provided:

- A photocopy of the Tax Return form of the applicant and the members of his/her family unit (even though the applicant may no longer be under their responsibility) applied to the last tax year.
- A photocopy of the applicant's academic certification together with the grades obtained and, if relevant, any other artistic or professional certificates.

The award of scholarships will be the responsibility of the Evaluating Committee of the Festival Internacional de Música y Danza de Granada. The Committee's resolution will be final.

Those applications not including the documentation required above will not be met.

The award of scholarships implies the obligation to attend the whole activity. No absences will be admitted, except those properly justified. Non-fulfillment of this obligation may be cause of revocation of the grant.

4.-Places and selection process

10 places for active students

Selection process

Those interested in taking part in the singing course are kindly requested to indicate in their application form a link (YouTube or similar) to a video with good sound and image quality and a duration of at least 5 minutes. They must indicate in the application form, the repertoire to be presented during the classes. Selection will be made by the teacher and her decision will be final. Result of the selection process will be notified by e-mail to applicants.

Observers will be welcome according to the capacity of the venue. Applications will be admitted by order of reception (they must include a CV).

4. Recording and public communication

Participants authorize the organization of the Manuel de Falla courses to take images or to record classes, rehearsals, and final concert where they take part, for archives and promotional (non- commercial) purposes.

5. Liability

Manuel de Falla Courses decline all responsibility for accident of the participants in the course, except in the case that the accident has been directly caused by a negligence attributable to the

Courses. The organization declares to have subscribed all the Insurance Policies intended to cover the civil liability of the activities organized.

6. Personal data protection

All personal data provided by the applicants will be protected by the Spanish and European laws of protection of personal data.

7. Certificate of participation

Participants who prove attendance at least 80% of the course may obtain a diploma and a certificate of attendance, which must be requested in writing, addressed to cursos@granadafestival.org. The certificate will be sent by e-mail.

8. Accommodation

Information on accommodation in Granada will be provided to those students who request it. Those interested must formalize their reservations directly with the chosen establishment.
